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
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1. General description of the data set.

A subsample of longitudinal data from the project BAF+IA (Barcelona Age Factor+ Input Aptitude). This data set contains the +transcriptions of the EFL ORAL production task + the matching sound files + EFL written compositions. The subjects (N=21) performed the tasks twice: N=6 at Time 1 and Time 2 (1 year interval); N=15 at Time 1 and Time 3 (2 years interval)
